Level 1 Award in Preparing to Work in Adult Social Care

This qualification aims to develop knowledge and/or skills in a subject area, prepare individuals for employment in a broad occupational area and prepares individuals for employment in specific occupational areas in the health and social care sector.

This qualification is vocationally based and as such, offers the opportunity for learners to demonstrate achievement of knowledge, understanding and practical skills in one of a variety of roles in the healthcare support environment, for example, in Adult Nursing Support, Maternity Support and Physiotherapy Support.

Learners must be in a position to demonstrate the requirements of the qualification and have access to required assessment opportunities and relevant resources. Learners are expected to have achieved a minimum of a Level 2 Functional Skills in English and maths.

How long will it take me to achieve this qualification?

The total qualification time for this qualification is 60 hours, of which 53 are recommended as guided learning hours.

Learners must achieve all 45 credits from the 15 mandatory units and a minimum of 20 credits from Mandatory Group B. A minimum of 37 credits overall must be at Level 3 or above.

How is the qualification assessed?

This qualification is internally set and internally assessed. Assessment activity must ensure evidence of achievement against all of the assessment criteria specified within each Unit.

What next?

Learners successfully completing this qualification may wish to progress onto further qualifications, such as:

- Level 3 Diploma in Adult Care.
- Degree in an appropriate area of specialism.
- Employment in a relevant Healthcare Support Worker role.
