Level 2 Award in Health and Safety within the Workplace (RQF)

This qualification has been designed specifically for those individuals who are required to have a basic knowledge of health and safety practices that are essential in the workplace. It is also ideal for those entering the workplace for the first time or looking to progress in an organisation.

The qualification covers the following topics:

- The duties and responsibilities of employers and employees.
- The benefits of good health and safety in the workplace.
- The process of risk assessment.
- Hazards and controls in the workplace.
- Responding to accidents, near misses and ill-health in the workplace.
- Emergency procedures.
- The importance of reporting accidents.

How long will it take me to achieve this qualification?

The total qualification time for this qualification is 10 hours and of this 6 hours is recommended as guided learning hours.

How is the qualification assessed?

The qualification is assessed through a multiple-choice question (MCQ) examination. This method of assessment is an end-of-course exam and must follow the Highfield Qualifications Examination and Invigilation Procedures. The examination for this qualification contains 20 questions that must be completed within 45 minutes. Successful learners will have to demonstrate knowledge and understanding across the qualification syllabus and achieve a minimum pass mark of 60%.

- Level 2 Diploma in Team Leading
- Level 3 Diploma in Management
